The following is a comprehensive equity, access, and inclusion policy providing considerations and guidance for decision-makers as well as event participants in the form of employees, partners, sponsors, contractors, speakers, volunteers, visitors, attendees, or others affiliated with Grandma's Marathon.

DECLARATION OF INCLUSION

On behalf of Grandma's Marathon, we hereby declare an invitation to participate in the event to all interested and willing parties. Our intention is to create an event that adheres to principles of social equity and inclusion and is open, welcoming, safe, and accessible for all who have an interest in participating (provided they have obtained a valid pass of entry to the event).

STATEMENT OF ACCESSIBILITY
